

Striding Edge to Helvellyn – Sponsorship Form

The route they have planned is Helvellyn via Striding Edge, a rocky ridge with big drops on either side leading to the Lakeland's second highest range which, at its highest point, stands at 950m or 3117ft above sea level. From Stick's Pass, they will head east, then south east and then join up with Glenridding Beck which will lead them back to Glenridding. This walk will be approximately 10 miles in length on difficult and exposed terrain and should take approx. eight hours to complete. They hope to do this in late spring or early summer of 2008.
